AFTER SCHOOL

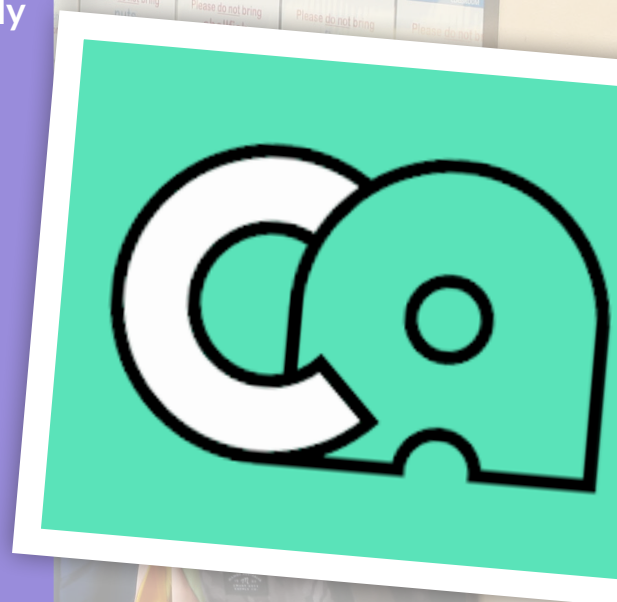
